IV: GROUP USE (excerpt)

C. The requesting Authorized User or Renter **MUST** accompany their groups' activity at all times. The Authorized User or Renter making reservations **MUST** be present for the entire event.

III: GUIDELINES FOR USE OF THE PARK

- A. Conduct: All patrons using the facility are expected to behave with courtesy and respect to park staff and all other patrons. Patrons are expected to follow all posted rules and comply with all reasonable requests or directions of the park staff.

The following are PROHIBITED at all WTMC facilities at all times:

1. Aggressive behavior or fighting
 2. Possession of alcohol or any other controlled substance.
 3. Possession of weapons of any type, including but not limited to paintball/air guns. (Folding pocket knives with blades of less than 2 ½ inches are not considered a weapon)
 4. Possession of any explosive device, including but not limited to fireworks, ammunition, and blasting caps.
 5. Pets of any type (Does not apply to Service Animals or Bankers Spit Park)
 6. Being in the facilities or leaving a vehicle in a park after the posted closing time.
 7. Except for wheel chairs and strollers, operating vehicles with wheels on the grass.
 8. Damage to any property within the WTMC facilities.
 9. Engaging in any unlawful activities as defined by Washington State Statues or Pierce County Code.
- B. Failure to follow the rules of conduct:
1. Patrons whose conduct fails to comply with #III A (above), are subject to loss of park privileges.
 2. Any patron who fails to follow park staff direction or behaves in an intimidating or threatening manner must leave the park immediately and may result in further restriction of park privileges. Further disciplinary action may include the Authorized Users' key card being suspended or revoked.
 3. Conduct which violates #III A, 1-9 (above) may result in arrest and prosecution by civil authorities and or civil suit by WTMC, its insurance company or other injured party.
 4. Vehicles left in the park in violation of #III A-6 (above) may be towed at the owner's risk and expense.
